

REPORT 2019

1. Highlights in 2019

In 2019, we were not aware of any particular problems with the authorities. Thanks to constructive dialogues, some families were able to enforce their non-didactic pedagogical choices and to find arrangements with the inspectors so that the control was not carried out in a scholastic manner or conflictual point of views could be resolved.

Two representatives of the inspectorate, one for the primary and one for the secondary, participated in the workshop of Dr. Peter Gray of the Alliance for Self-Directed Education, organised with a conference thanks to the support of Arcus asbl.

We consolidated our exchanges with international groups to promote respect for human rights in education and to increase awareness of non-conventional educational models.

We collaborated in the Follereau Foundation's project "Challenge for a better world". This event included a round table and workshops on June 12 and 13, 2020 and had to be postponed due to the pandemic. We hope that our guests: Ramin FARHANGI (www.villagedepourgues.coop), Fari KHABIRPOUR (www.farikhabirpour.com), Sophie RHABI (www.la-ferme-des-enfants.com), Céline VEITMANN (www.seveluxembourg.org), Jean-Marie WEBER (www.uni.lu) and the moderators Jean-Philippe WAGNON (www.allagi.lu) as well as Christophe WATELET (teacher) will still be there in 2021 to discuss the question **« Towards a holistic, conscious and living education ? »**.

The bill on homeschooling has still not been deposited in the Chamber of Deputies, but we have been invited to the Ministry to discuss it.
